LITERACY/NUMERACY NEWS

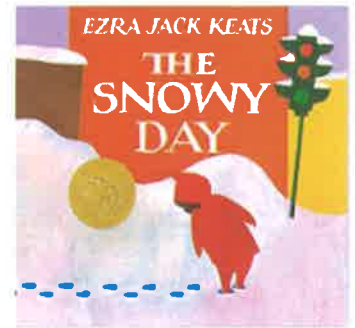
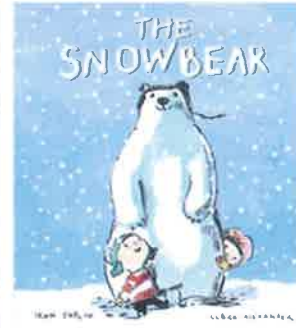
December is a great month to start up family game nights. Games encourage vocabulary, discussions, and conversations skills. They also help develop problem solving and numeracy skills.

Playing musical instruments or singing is another way to build literacy skills together at home.

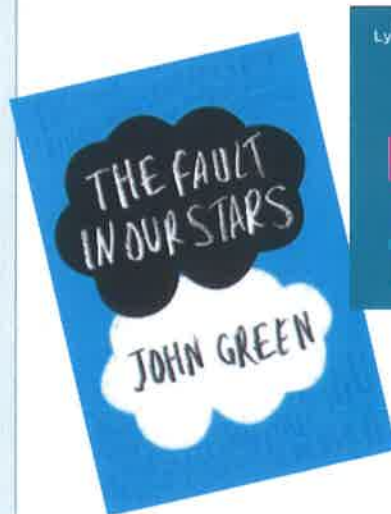
Baking and cooking together is another great way to build literacy and numeracy skills with our children.
